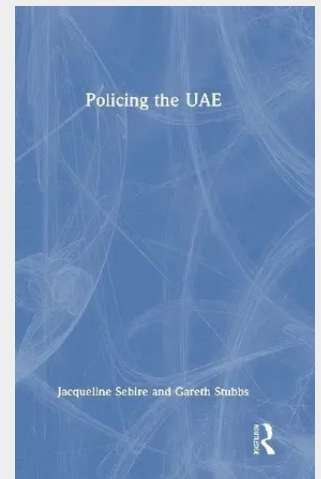


Policing the UAE
