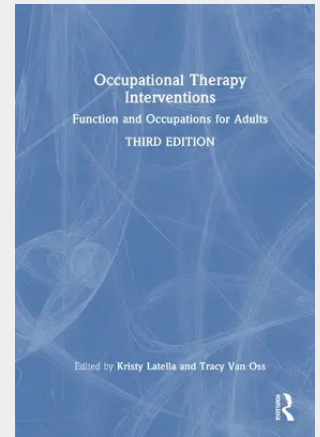


Occupational Therapy Interventions
