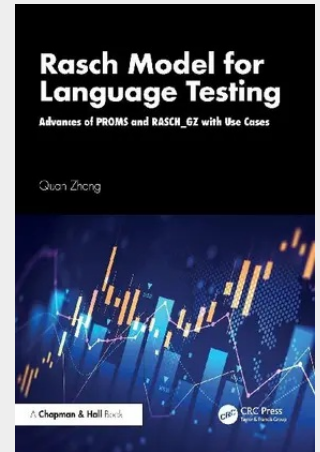


Rasch Model for Language Testing
