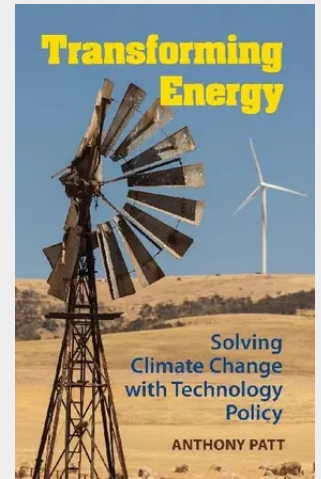


Transforming Energy
