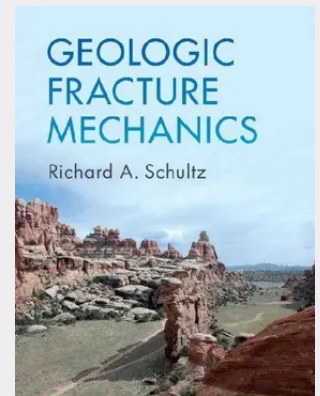


## Geologic Fracture Mechanics
