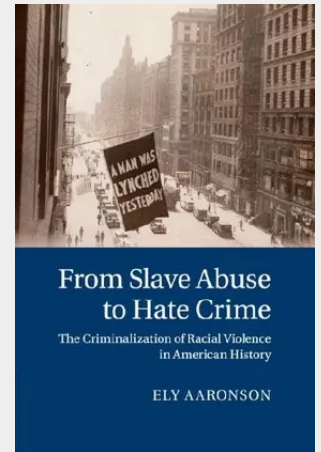


From Slave Abuse to Hate Crime
