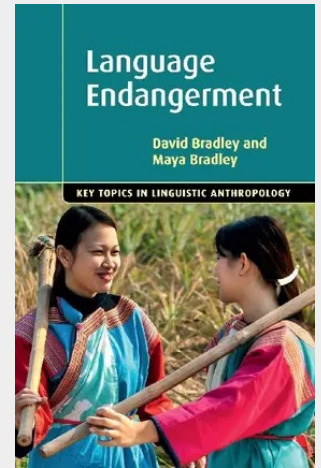


Language Endangerment
