

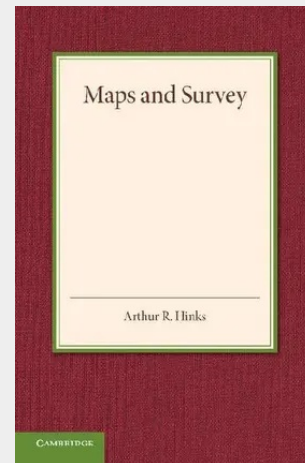

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Arthur Robert Hinks (1873-1945) was a renowned British astronomer and geographer.
