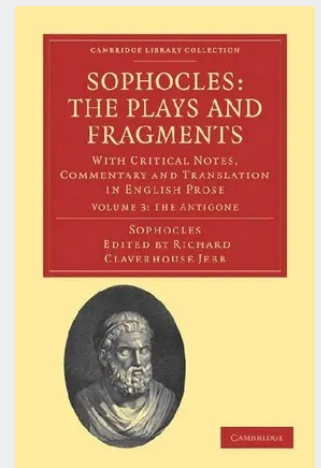


Sophocles
