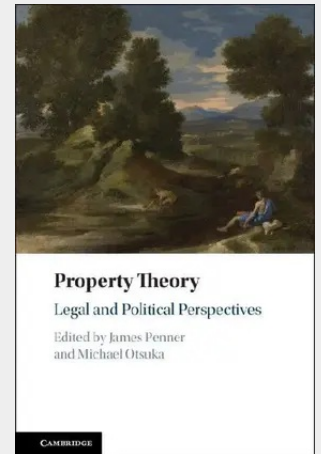


Property Theory
