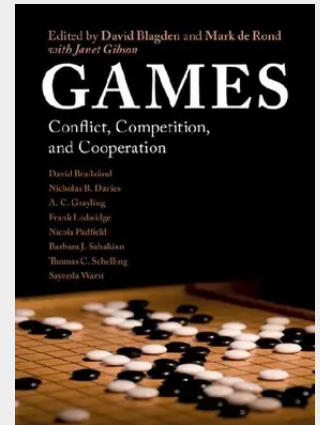


Games
