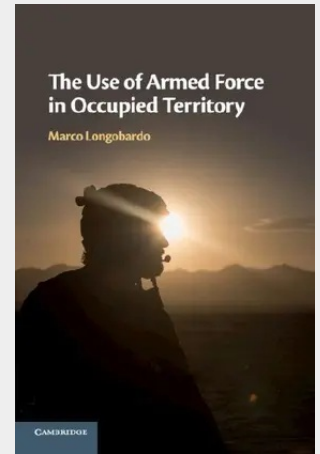


The Use of Armed Force in Occupied Territory
