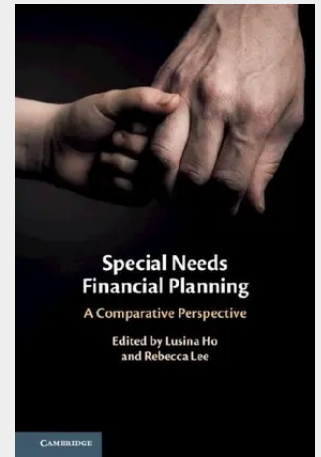


Special Needs Financial Planning
