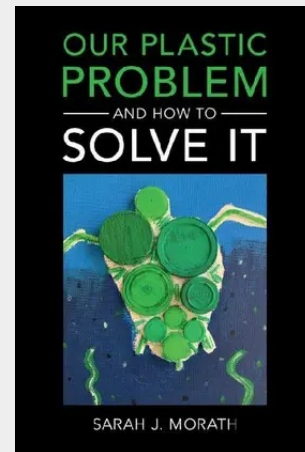


Our Plastic Problem and How to Solve It
