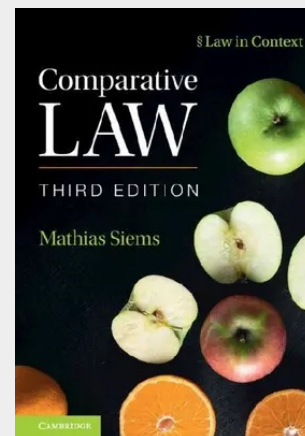


Comparative Law
