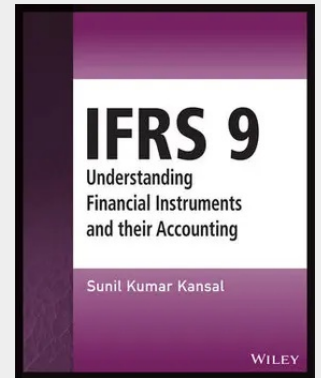


Ifrs 9
