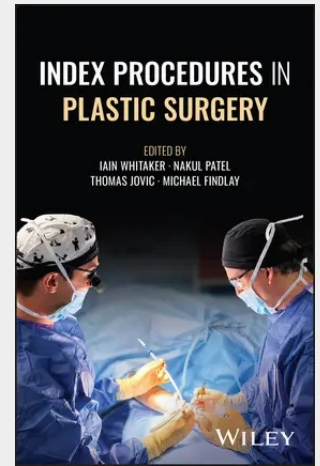

Index Procedures in Plastic Surgery is an essential reference on the subject for both trainees and trainers alike. Surgical researchers, medical students, general practitioners, and specialist nurses and professionals from specialties allied to plastic surgery will also find value in this text.



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
