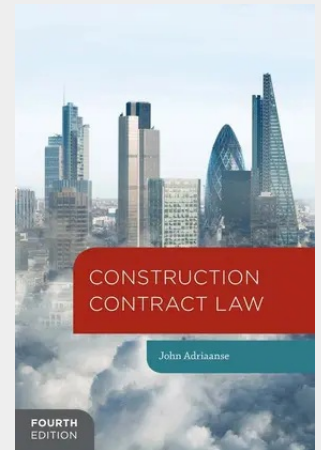


Construction Contract Law
