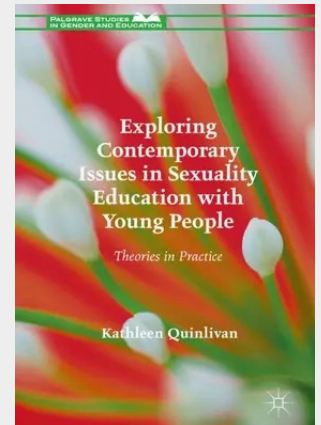


Exploring Contemporary Issues in Sexuality Education with Young People
