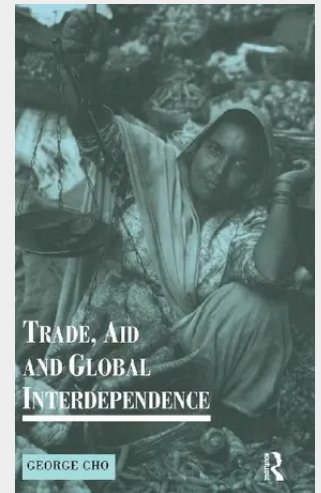


Trade, Aid and Global Interdependence
