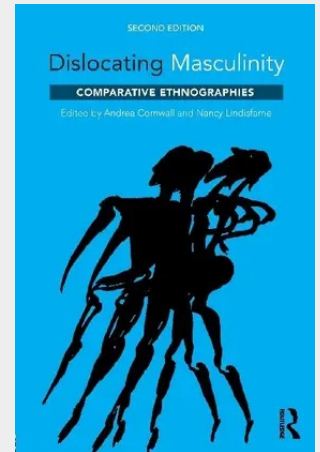


Dislocating Masculinity
