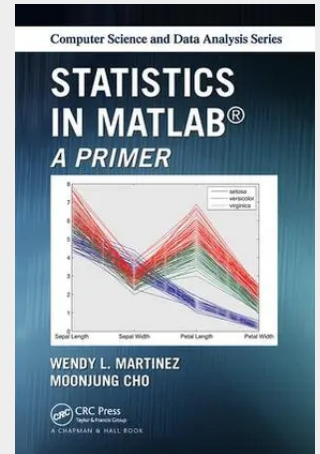


Statistics in MATLAB
