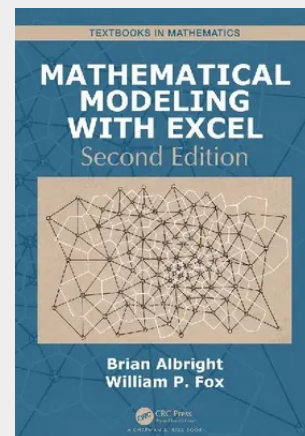


Mathematical Modeling with Excel
