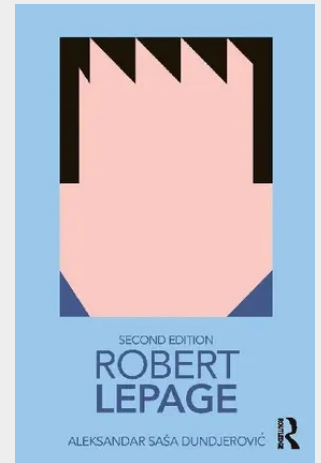


Robert Lepage
