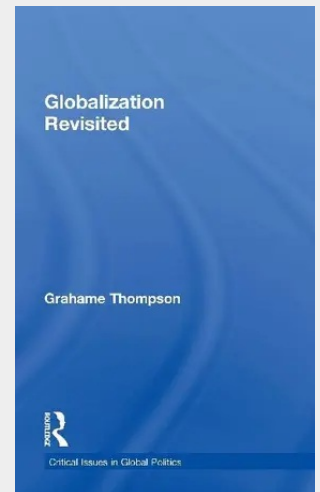


Globalization Revisited
