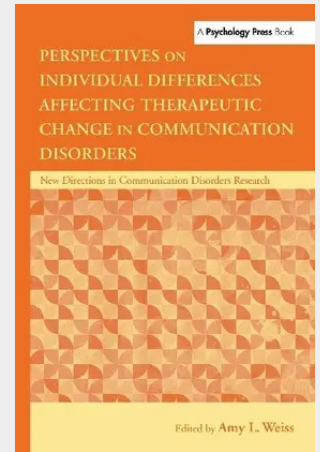


Perspectives on Individual Differences Affecting Therapeutic Change in Communication Disorders
