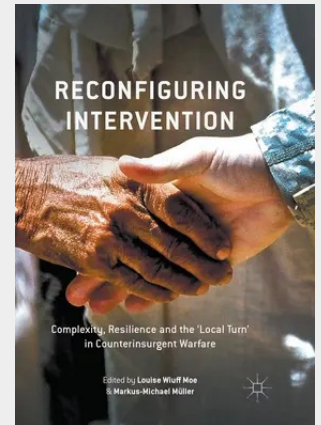


Reconfiguring Intervention
