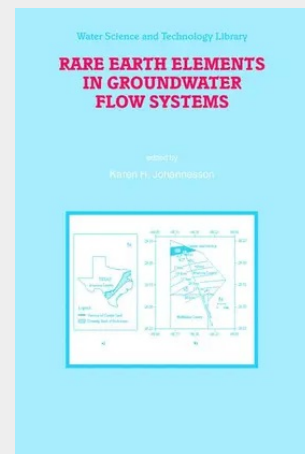


Rare Earth Elements in Groundwater Flow Systems
