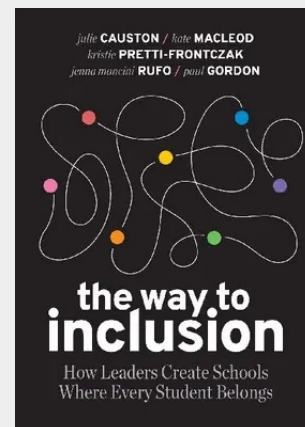


Way to Inclusion
