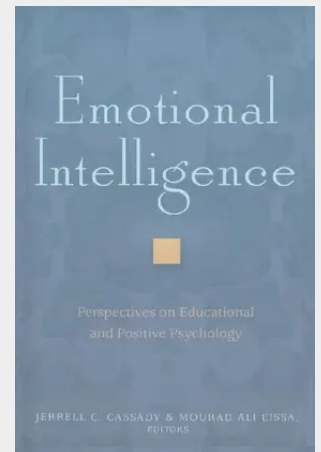


Emotional Intelligence
