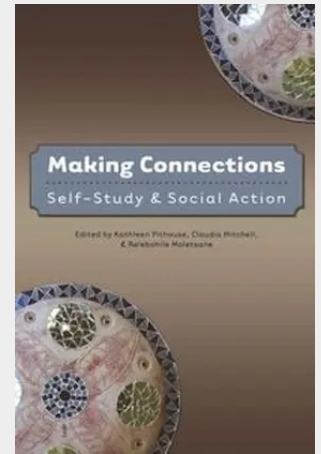


Making Connections
