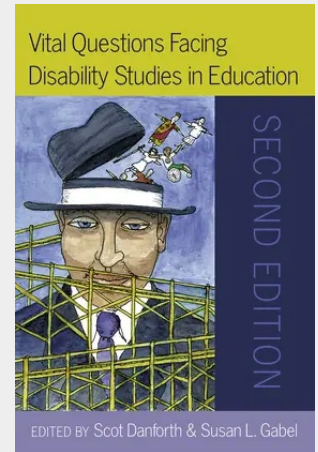


Vital Questions Facing Disability Studies in Education
