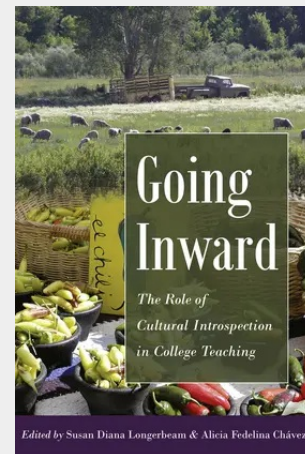


Going Inward
