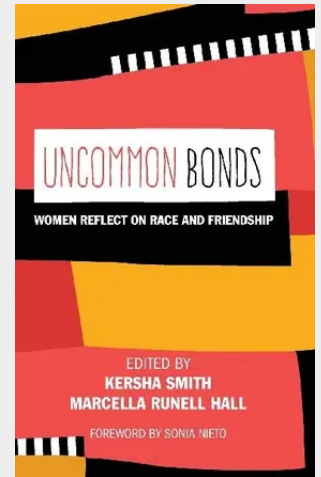


UnCommon Bonds
