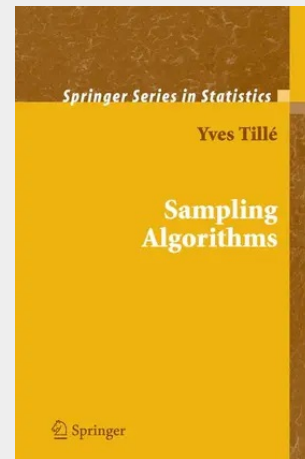


Sampling Algorithms
