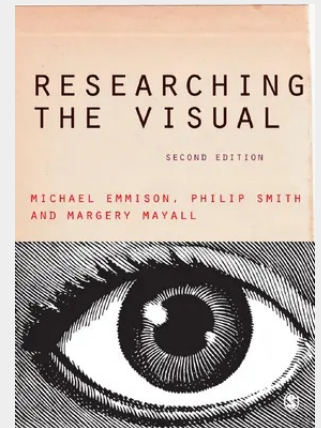


Researching the Visual
