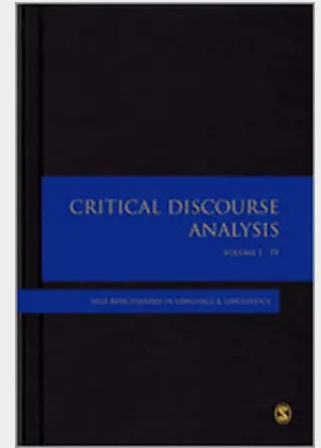


## Critical Discourse Analysis
