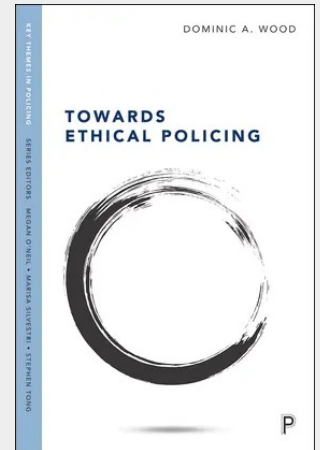


Towards Ethical Policing
