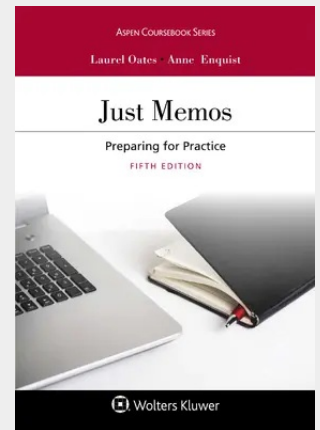


Just Memos: Preparing for Practice
