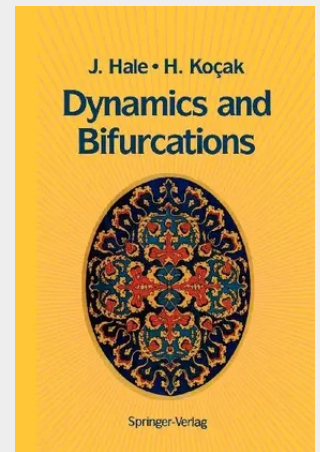


Dynamics and Bifurcations
