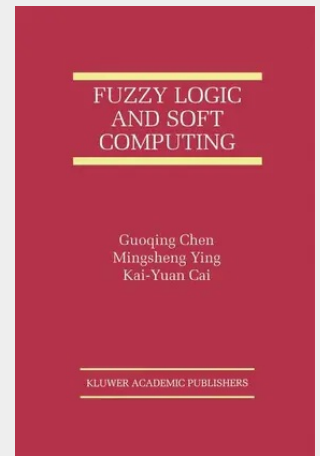


Fuzzy Logic and Soft Computing
