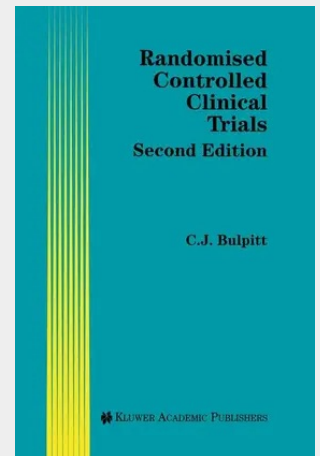


Randomised Controlled Clinical Trials
