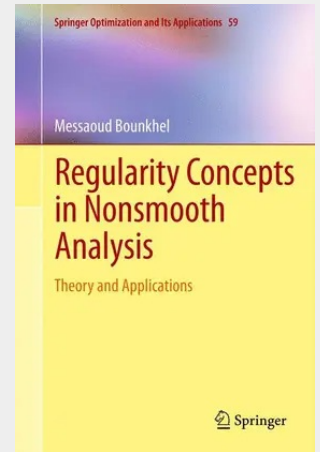


Regularity Concepts in Nonsmooth Analysis
