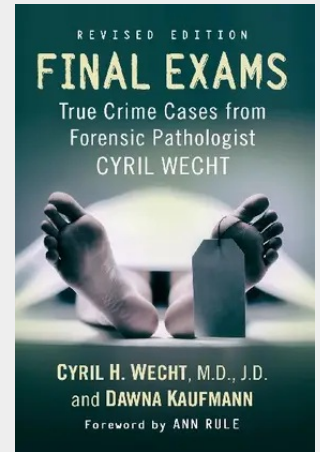


Final Exams
