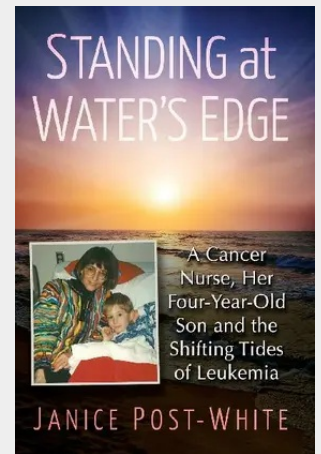


Standing at Water's Edge
