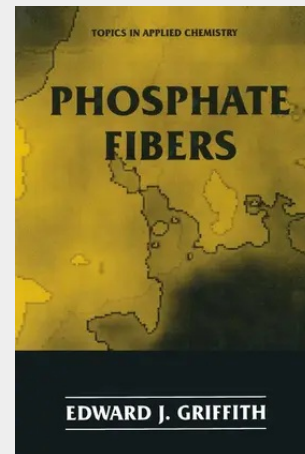


Phosphate Fibers
