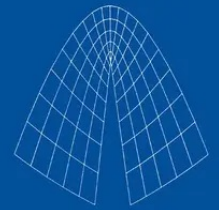


Scientific Computing on Supercomputers III

The International Workshop on "The Use of Supercomputers in Theoretical Science" took place on January 24 and 25, 1991, at the University of Antwerp (UIA), Antwerpen, Belgium. It was the sixth in a series of workshops, the first of which took place in 1984. The principal aim of these workshops is to present the state of the art in scientific large-scale and high speed-computation.
