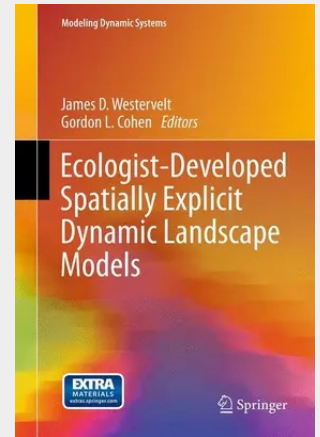


Ecologist-Developed Spatially-Explicit Dynamic Landscape Models
