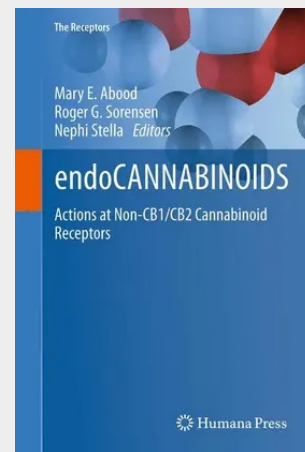


## endoCANNABINOIDS
