

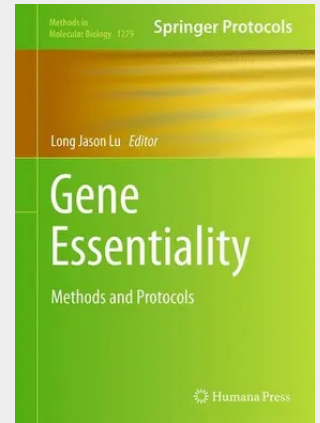
Gene Essentiality
